FABRIC DYEING I

Dye several shades of one color, then learn how to mix colors to create your own 12 step color wheels of fabric!

SUPPLY LIST

Wear old clothes and shoes. We will be outdoors so dress for the weather. Even if it is hot, it is best to have legs and feet covered-spills happen!

Please bring a folding table and/or chair if you have one. I only have tables for 6 or 7 and no chairs. Bring a brown-bag lunch.

- *Rubber gloves
- *Large plastic bucket. the bigger the better.
- *Empty gallon container(such as a milk jug)with the lid.

Plastic dish pan

Plastic measuring spoons-metal can react with the dyes. Do not reuse with food!

Plastic measuring cups

Permanent marking pen

Scissors

Yardstick

- *2 small empty bottles or jars, glass or plastic
- *20-40 one-gallon zip lock bags-avoid flat bottoms, and ones with a plastic zipper pull-these tend to leak.
- *roll of paper towels
- * absolute must-haves: anything else I probably have extras that can be used in class

10 yds of prepared for dyeing fabric is provided in the class. Additional will be available for purchase at the wholesale price of \$5.

Price will be \$85 and will include 10 yards of PFD fabric, all dyes and chemicals, and instructions.
